The CNC Region Board of Directors is offering one \$350.00 Bursary Award to a Graduating CNCR skating member of Skate Canada. We don't want to miss the opportunity for any of our skating family so please copy and circulate this memo to all of your eligible skaters in order that they have an opportunity to apply for this scholarship award.

Criteria and Description of the award is as follows:

DESCRIPTION:

This award is established to provide financial assistance for a CNCR skater who plans to pursue a post secondary education (University, College, Vocational or Technological Institute)

NUMBER OF AWARDS: ONE (1) Award: \$350.00

ELIGIBILITY

1. Candidates must intend to pursue post-secondary education in a field of their choice.
2. Candidates must currently be enrolled in a School District within the CNC Region.
3. Candidates must be a current Skate Canada skating member, registered in a club within the CNC Region.
4. Academic standing will be a consideration but not the total deciding factor.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

1. Any recipient unable to continue his/her education in the year immediately following graduation may defer the award for one year.
2. Selection to be made by the CNC Region Board of Directors.
3. Deadline for the 2008 application is May 1st, 2008.

3. Additional Student Information (brief essay)
4. Reference letter from an Official of the skater's Skate Canada Club.
5. Reference Letter or Letters from person(s) not involved in skating. (ie. School counselor, teacher, employer)
