

MUSIC AND ICE SHOWS - SOCAN

Spring is almost here and ice show season is upon us! Music is an integral part of ice shows and it is important that clubs are in compliance with the laws for music use. The Skate Canada agreement covers club programs but does not cover ice shows and competitions.

Follow the steps below to ensure you have everything covered for your ice show:

Determine whether your municipality already pays SOCAN fees under Tariff 21. If the answer is yes, you are already covered. Get confirmation in writing so that you have it if needed.

If the answer above is no, then you need to apply to SOCAN for a license under Tariff 11A. You can find that application here:

Within 7 days following the ice show complete and submit this application with the appropriate payment.
